Monterey County residents will have their basic needs met for food, shelter, and safety.

- Individuals and families have enough food to eat daily.
- Individuals and families have stable, adequate, and safe shelter.
- People in the community know where to go to ask for help.

Self-Sufficiency

Monterey County residents will have the lifelong skills to support themselves and their families.

- People acquire life skills, including financial literacy, cyber literacy and wellness.
- The current and future workforce is literate and has achieved an adequate educational level.
- People can attain and sustain safe, independent, secure and affordable housing.

Successful Kids and Strong Families

Monterey County families, children and youth develop their full potential, live safe and healthy lives and contribute positively to society.

- Youth/Young adults will earn a high school diploma or equivalency.
- Families benefit from constructive interaction with the natural environment, building and exhibiting strong positive relationships among family members.
- Children and teens will exhibit leadership, positive self-esteem, confidence, positive coping skills and positive relationships with others.

Crisis to Stability

Monterey County residents will have resources to prevent and resolve crises such as domestic violence, mental health issues, and substance abuse.

- People receive adequate short and long term intervention, services, etc. for behavioral health issues.
- Prevention and early intervention programs increase capacity to avoid crisis.
