REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS: Phase 36

Dear Applicant:

To qualify for consideration for funding under the Emergency Food & Shelter Program, an applicant agency must:

- ◆ Be nonprofit or an agency of government
- ◆ Have an accounting system
- ◆ Practice nondiscrimination
- ◆ Have demonstrated the capacity to deliver Emergency Food and/or Shelter Programs and/or Shelter
- ◆ Have a voluntary Board of Directors (if a private organization)

Applicant organizations will be requested to provide proof of their status with respect to the above.

The Local Emergency Food & Shelter Board prioritizes eligible activities and how funds will be awarded and distributed among local emergency food and/or shelter programs. Only eligible activities, as determined by the National Emergency Food & Shelter Board will be funded.

The amount of funding to be awarded to Monterey County is \$328,297. Our goal is to distribute between 10-15 grants.

The spending period for this grant is from October 1st, 2018 to March 31st, 2020. Grant funding can be used to reimburse expenses incurred prior to receiving funding.

To have your application considered for funding by the Local Emergency Food & Shelter Board you must have filed all required reports and have had those reports accepted by the national EFS board.
