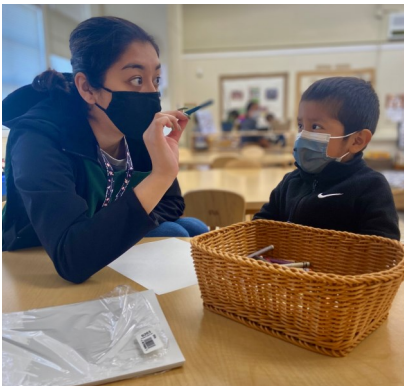

This early learning initiative helps children reach age level in language and literacy and supports kindergarten readiness. In the 2020 academic year, the program served 40 children. In 2021, the program proudly entered its second year, with AmeriCorps members serving in preschool classrooms throughout the county and providing individualized tutoring to over 240 children.
